

Assisting employees to return to work after an injury or illness

The fall schedule for the 25 online workshops offered by the National Institute of Disability Management and Research is available now. These modules explore strategies for working with employees with impairments and for developing a program and structure that will support return-to-work activities.

You can enroll in all 25 modules and earn a certificate of completion or select a few modules for continuing professional development. Most modules require 10 to 12 hours of study activity over a one-week period.

Course materials can be downloaded on the Thursday before activities begin—including the module manual, readings, quizzes, samples and examples, exercises, an assignment, and in some cases, other media.

During the module, commonly encountered situations will be discussed in online forums that are led by an instructor who specializes in the module topic area. A short assignment is submitted at the end of the week.
